The Corporations Canada Web site offers:

- · online incorporation and online filing services;
- the Small Business Guide to Federal Incorporation;
- information on choosing a name for your corporation, including an online training course on name-granting guidelines;
- access to Newly Upgraded Automated Name Search (NUANS) reports to help in selecting an appropriate name for a new corporation;
- · online search capability to find information related to federal corporations;
- information on legislation pertaining to federal corporations, not-for-profit organizations and cooperatives;
- general information on federal incorporation, such as the benefits and the costs of federal incorporation; and
- extra-provincial registration in some provinces.

The Web site also provides access to most of the forms needed by business corporations to remain compliant under the *Canada Business Corporations Act*. As an added bonus, you can do most of your filing online, including filing of annual returns, and thereby take advantage of reduced fees!
