Mandatory Change for FIRST Release Option

- 1. This notice is a follow-up to Customs Notice N-452 issued on July 4, 2002, on the requirement for drivers requesting release under the FIRST option to be registered under the Commercial Driver Registration Program (CDRP).
- 2. The requirement for drivers reporting under the FIRST option to present a CDRP card scheduled to take effect April 1, 2003, is postponed indefinitely.
- 3. All aspects of the FIRST release process will remain unchanged, including the normal processing of drivers at the primary inspection line (PIL).

- 4. Drivers are strongly encouraged to apply under the CDRP program so that they will be in compliance when this requirement is re-introduced.
