# CUSTOMS NOTICE N-522

## Filling of the Barley Products Tariff Rate Quota

1. This notice covers commercial importations of barley products of heading Nos. 11.02, 11.03, 11.04, 11.07, 11.08, 19.01, 19.04, and 23.02 in the List of Tariff Provisions set out in the schedule to the *Customs Tariff*, which is listed in items 183 to 191 of the Import Control List.

2. Importers of barley products are advised that the Minister of Foreign Affairs has determined that the barley products tariff rate quota (TRQ) for the period of August 1, 2002, to July 31, 2003, will be filled on July 18, 2003. Consequently, July 18, 2003 (at midnight), will be the cut-off date to account for imports of all barley products classified under a "within access commitment" tariff item. Imports of barley products accounted for after July 18, 2003, and until July 31, 2003, must be classified under the applicable "over access commitment" tariff item.

3. July 18, 2003, will be the last day that importers may use the General Import Permit (GIP) No. 20 to account for barley products classified under a "within access commitment" tariff item. The GIP No. 20 will be suspended for barley products until July 31, 2003. **The GIP No. 20 will remain in effect to authorize the importation of wheat and barley that are listed in items 161 and 182 of the Import Control List.** The GIP No. 100 will cover unlimited imports of barley products up to July 31, 2003, where the barley products are classified under an "over access commitment" tariff item.

4. The rates of duty applicable to "over access commitment" barley products qualifying for the *United States Tariff*, the *Mexico Tariff*, the *Chile Tariff*, or the *Costa Rica Tariff* are the same as the rates of duty of the corresponding "within access commitment" tariff items.

5. Goods imported under the authority of GIP No. 100 that are required to be reported in the prescribed form under the *Customs Act* must include the statement "Imported Under the Authority of General Import Permit No. 100 – Eligible Agricultural Goods."
