CUSTOMS NOTICE N-527

Elimination of Customs D Memoranda

1. The purpose of this notice is to inform all customs personnel that the following four Customs D memoranda relating to Industry Canada (IC) have been eliminated:

- D19-4-2, *Radiocommunications Act* and Regulations
- D19-5-2, *Consumer Packaging and Labelling Act* and Regulations
- D19-5-3, *Textile Labelling Act* and *Textile Labelling and Advertising Regulations*
- D19-5-4, *Precious Metals Marking Act* and Regulations

2. The Canada Customs and Revenue Agency (CCRA) has undertaken a comprehensive review of the commercial and travellers' programs. This review resulted from the CCRA's decision to encourage a risk management approach to administering other government department (OGD) programs at the border and to formalize the CCRA and OGD roles and responsibilities in program-specific memoranda of understanding.

3. The CCRA is working with IC to develop a targeted and risk management approach to administering regulations on behalf of IC at the border. Headquarters will use a targeted approach to deal with the border requirements of these IC programs.
