Decline in the Rental Stock causes a Drop in Vacancies

According to the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation's (CMHC) annual rental market survey, the vacancy rate in the privately owned rental apartment market in Thompson declined from 9.3 per cent in October 2002 to 7.9 per cent in October 2003. The primary factor behind the vacancy decline was the removal of several units from the market, mainly due to renovation.

In 2002, the vacancy rate had increased sharply following the return on the market of many renovated units . This year, the opposite phenomenon is occurring, as 63 units were pulled from the stock to be renovated. These changes in the number of units in the market are the main cause of the vacancy rate fluctuations. On the demand side, the number of occupied units declined slightly from 1,487 in October 2002 to 1,477 units in October 2003. Over the same period, the number of units in stock diminished by 36 units to 1,604, thus the decline in the vacancy rate.

The average rent for all bedroom types increased by 1.2 per cent between the two surveys. At 2.5 per cent, bachelor units saw the greatest hike.. Rents also increased for the two-bedrooms apartments, by 2.1 per cent, and for the one-bedroom units, by 0.2 per cent. Meanwhile, the average rent for three-and-more-bedroom apartments decreased by 3.7 per cent.
