Moncton CA Highlights

Vacancy Rate Up Slightly

Results of the Fall 2002 Rental Market Survey indicate that there were more vacancies in the Greater Moncton area this year. Following low vacancy levels in 2000 and 2001, the vacancy rate increased slightly to 2.3 per cent in October of this year.

A significant increase in the supply of new rental units is viewed as the main factor which contributed to higher vacancies in the Greater Moncton area. The number of new units coming onto the market in 2002 reached a near record high. Notwithstanding, record employment levels combined with in-migration continue to support strong demand in the rental market.

Vacancies went up in all bedroom types, except for bachelors. Several hundred new high-end units coming onto the market over the last twelve months have caused the average rent to rise by 3.6 per cent to \$545.
