Vacancy rate up in Belleville

According to figures released today from Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation's Rental Market Survey, the rental vacancy rate in the Belleville-Quinte area increased this year to 3.9 per cent, up from the 3.5 per cent recorded in 2002.

Softening demand pushed vacancy rates up for all unit types in Belleville-Quinte. The vacancy rate for bachelor suites almost doubled from the 4.4 per cent recorded in 2002 to 8.4 per cent this year. Vacancy rates slightly increased for one- and three+ bedroom units, while two-bedroom units saw an increase to 3.7 per cent.

The City of Belleville recorded a lower vacancy rate when compared to Quinte West. In the City of Belleville, the vacancy rate is 2.5 per cent, same as it was back in 2002. Meanwhile, Quinte West's vacancy rate increased to 7.4 per cent in 2003, up from the 6.0 per cent last year.

With tighter rental market conditions last year, average rents this year went up as a result. The average monthly rent for a two-bedroom rental unit increased by 3.4 per cent to \$692 per month. The average rent for one bedroom units increased by 3.7 per cent and by under 5 per cent for rental units with three or more bedrooms. The tighter rental market conditions in the City of Belleville last year clearly pushed the average rents up in this area.

CMHC's rental market survey is conducted every year in early October and measures trends in the private row and apartment rentals for the Belleville-Quinte area.
