# Vacancy Rate Moves Higher in 2003

The Hamilton Census Metropolitan Area (CMA) vacancy rate moved higher this year nearly doubling to 3.0 percent compared to 1.6 percent in 2002, according to the annual October Rental Market Survey released by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC). The CMHC survey found 1,269 vacant privately owned apartments in the CMA, up from 665 one year ago. Mortgage rates near historic lows kept home ownership carrying costs at low levels resulting in a many tenants making the move into home ownership. While rental demand was moving lower, rental supply increased by 417 apartment units to 42,212 private rental apartments.

After four consecutive years of recording a vacancy rate below two percent, the Hamilton rental market eased significantly recording its highest vacancy rate since 1998. Vacancy rates increased for all bedroom types ranging from a high of 4.9 percent for bachelor units to 1.7 percent for apartments with three or more bedrooms. The most common rental apartments, one and two bedrooms, recorded vacancy rates of 3.2 and 2.8 percent respectively.

Higher vacancy rates this year translated into lower rent increases. The average private apartment rent (all units) increased 1.6 percent this year. Units with three or more bedrooms even registered a decline of \$6, while all other apartment types saw modest rent increases.

Within the Hamilton CMA, the old city of Hamilton recorded the highest apartment vacancy rate at 3.7 percent and Burlington recorded the lowest rate at 0.6 percent.
