## **Cancellation of Memorandum D19-9-7, *Importation of Human Semen***

This notice advises that the Canada Customs and Revenue Agency (CCRA) has reviewed its role at the border in the administration of the *Processing and Distribution of Semen for Assisted Conception Regulations* issued under the authority of the *Food and Drugs Act*. While the CCRA continues to assist Health Canada through information sharing, border interventions will no longer be necessary.

In light of this decision, Memorandum D19-9-7, *Importation of Human Semen*, is cancelled.
