CUSTOMS NOTICE 637

Customs Sufferance Warehouses

1. The purpose of this notice is to advise that effective March 31, 2006, Intermediate Terminals Warehousing Inc. has surrendered its highway sufferance warehouse licence in Oshawa, Ontario. The Canada Border Services Agency is currently in the process of seeking an interested party to operate the highway sufferance warehouse in the Oshawa area. Until this process is completed, all bonded carriers transporting in-bond commercial highway freight destined for clearance at the Oshawa highway sufferance warehouse must report to one of the following highway sufferance warehouses in the Greater Toronto Area as of April 1, 2006:

Port 499 – Toronto Sufferance Truck Terminal
2055 Kennedy Road, Scarborough, Ontario

Port 496 – TFI Transport 8 L.P. (Interport)
5425 Dixie Road, Mississauga, Ontario

Port 495 – Transcargo Centre, Division of Schenker of
Canada Limited
3210 Airway Drive, Mississauga, Ontario

2. In addition, TST Overland Express, a division of TST Solutions L.P., is surrendering its highway sufferance warehouse licences in Collingwood and Midland, Ontario, effective April 28, 2006. Therefore, as of April 29, 2006, all bonded highway carriers transporting in-bond commercial highway freight destined for clearance at the Collingwood and Midland highway sufferance warehouse must report to the highway sufferance warehouse located at 20 Elliott Street, Barrie, Ontario.
