

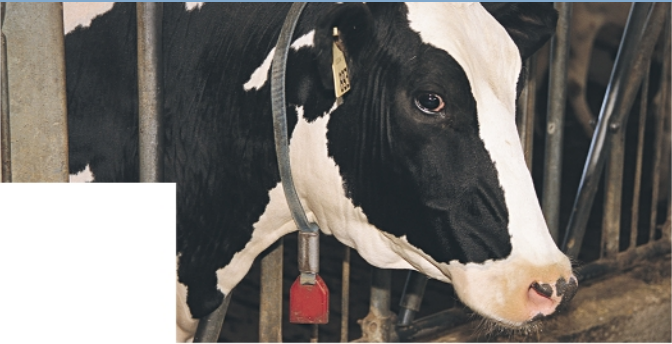

Based upon Statistics Canada data, the benchmarking reports allow you to compare your operation to other Canadian farm businesses in similar circumstances.

The basic financial information that you input regarding your farm operation is strictly confidential and is intended for your use only.

- Identify your farm's strengths, weaknesses and future opportunities.
- Compare your farm's performance to other operations.
- Learn best management practices to improve business.

Getting Started

- As of April 1, 2003, you can access the Benchmarking website at www.agr.gc.ca/compare.
- Then, it is simply a matter of entering some basic financial information into the spreadsheet that will be provided.
- After following a few easy steps, your results are automatically calculated, providing you with your benchmark report.
- Now you will be able to see how your business compares with industry peers in similar circumstances.
