

COSEWIC MANDATE

The Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada (COSEWIC) determines the national status of wild species, subspecies, varieties, and nationally significant populations that are considered to be at risk in Canada. Designations are made on all native species for the following taxonomic groups: mammals, birds, amphibians, reptiles, fish, molluscs, lepidopterans, vascular plants, lichens, and mosses. A record of status re-examinations is also maintained.

COSEWIC MEMBERSHIP

COSEWIC comprises representatives from each provincial and territorial government wildlife agency, four federal agencies (Canadian Wildlife Service, Parks Canada Agency, Department of Fisheries and Oceans, and the Federal Biosystematic Partnership), three national non-government organizations (Canadian Nature Federation, Canadian Wildlife Federation, and World Wildlife Fund Canada) and the co-chairs of the species specialist groups. The committee meets at least once per year to consider status reports on candidate species.

COSEWIC LISTS

The first COSEWIC "Endangered Species List" was issued in 1978. In 1990, it was decided that all species considered by COSEWIC should be listed even if the species were "not at risk" or "data deficient." Therefore, this document is divided into three separate lists.

- List 1: Species designated as Extinct, Extirpated, Endangered, Threatened or Special Concern, with geographical occurrence and date assessed.
- List 2: Species examined and designated in the Not at Risk category, with geographical occurrence and date assessed.
- List 3: Species examined and designated in the Data Deficient category because of insufficient scientific information, with geographical occurrence and date assessed.

A record of status re-assessments can be found at the back of the document.

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS AND RISK CATEGORIES

Species	Any indigenous species, subspecies, variety, or geographically defined population of wild fauna and flora.
Extinct (X)	A species that no longer exists.
Extirpated (XT)	A species no longer existing in the wild in Canada, but occurring elsewhere.
Endangered (E)	A species facing imminent extirpation or extinction.
Threatened (T)	A species likely to become endangered if limiting factors are not reversed.
Special Concern (SC)*	A species of special concern because of characteristics that make it particularly sensitive to human activities or natural events.
Not At Risk (NAR)**	A species that has been evaluated and found to be not at risk.
Data Deficient (DD)***	A species for which there is insufficient scientific information to support status designation.

COSEWIC has recently begun using quantitative criteria to assess species' risk of extinction. These criteria were adapted from the criteria used by the World Conservation Union (IUCN) and have been used by COSEWIC since October 1999.

The Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada (COSEWIC) was created in 1977 as a result of a recommendation at the Federal-Provincial Wildlife Conference held in 1976. It arose from the need for a single, official, scientifically sound, national listing of wildlife species at risk. In 1978, COSEWIC designated its first species and produced its first list of Canadian species at risk. Species designated at meetings of the full committee are added to the list.
