*Request for Additional Information or Test Results Concerning a Substance New to Canada that is Suspected of Being Toxic*

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to subsection 29(5) of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*, that the Ministers of Health and of the Environment have assessed information pertaining to *Poly(oxy-1,2-ethanediyl), a, a'-(iminodi-2,1-ethanediyl), bis[w-hydroxy-,N-[3-(C<sub>10</sub>-C<sub>16</sub>-alkyloxy)propyl] derivatives, diethyl sulfate-quaternized*, CAS Registry Number 70983-58-3, and suspect that the substance is "toxic", as defined under section 11 of the Act.

The Minister of the Environment is hereby pleased to request additional information or test results under paragraph 29(1)(c) of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act* in accordance with this request.

*Poly(oxy-1,2-ethanediyl), a, a'-(iminodi-2,1-ethanediyl), bis[w-hydroxy-,N-[3-(C<sub>10</sub>-C<sub>16</sub>-alkyloxy)propyl] derivatives, diethyl sulfate-quaternized*, CAS Registry Number 70983-58-3. The notifier must submit the information and complete test results, for the notified substance, of a 28-day repeated-dose oral study in rats, and a skin sensitization study conducted on guinea pigs. Both of these tests must be carried out using Health Canada approved test protocols.
