Instructions to Applicant

Places are offered on a competitive basis at the international, co-educational, residential colleges listed above for two years of education beyond the equivalent of eleven years of North American schooling. Substantial scholarship support is provided, enabling students to attend without regard to their financial means. Preference will be given to candidates of good academic standing, who will be between sixteen and seventeen and a half years on entry.

Your application must include

- Completed Scholarship Application form
- Transcript of academic marks for Grade 9/Secondary III, Grade 10/Secondary IV, Grade 11/Secondary V and/or most recent marks. In Quebec only – Ministère Sec. IV.
- Up to three letters of reference (see part VII)
- Student Evaluation form (to be given to school Principal and returned separately by them)

- Parts I, II, III, IV, V & VII are to be completed by the student.
- Part VI is to be completed by the parent or guardian.
- Part VIII is to be completed by your school Principal or representative and mailed to the Student Selection Coordinator under separate cover, to be received by FEBRUARY 15th. (Closing date for Canadian applicants — other countries may vary.)
