To the Cruise Traveller:

You are required to answer the following questions and inform the cruise line health personnel pre-departure whether you have answered YES to any of them.

While on board the cruise ship:

If you have travelled to a SARS-affected area outside of Canada or a SARS-affected site within Canada, and you have a fever **AND** one or more of the following respiratory symptoms - cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing - Health Canada recommends that you notify one of the cruise line health personnel immediately.
