POTENTIAL SARS EXPOSURE SITES

This chart provides the names of sites where there has been evidence of possible SARS transmission. The dates indicate the most recent episode of potential contact with a known SARS case before infection control precautions and quarantine measures were put in place.

Each site is considered a “past site” after 10 days (one incubation period), with no reported possible symptomatic cases. The site is considered risk free from further SARS transmission after 20 days have passed (two incubation periods).
