ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS The Canadian forces are tasked by the Canadian People and Parliament to protect Canadians and Canadian interests at home and overseas, and

WHEREAS the members of the Canadian Forces Reserve Force play a vital and essential role in this ever more important task, and

WHEREAS in British Columbia some two thousand five hundred and eighty men and woman are serving in the Reserve force in their local communities and on domestic and international operations, and

WHEREAS the members of the Reserve force make a significant contribution through their dedication to their families, communities, British Columbia and Canada, and;

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 30, 2006, shall be known as

"Canadian Forces Reserve Force Day"

in British Columbia;

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province to be hereunto affixed.
