The NOHFC Northern Ontario Young Entrepreneur Program aims to mobilize a new generation of entrepreneurs and community builders in the North to secure a prosperous future for tomorrow's families and workers.

Who Can Apply

- → Residents of Northern Ontario between 18 and 29 years old who are planning to start their own for-profit business in the North may be eligible to apply.
- → The new venture cannot be an expansion or natural extension of a similar business owned by the young entrepreneur and/or family members/relatives.

What is Eligible

→ Costs that may qualify for funding include but are not limited to capital costs related to starting the new business such as office furniture, fixtures and equipment.

Funding

- → Generally, funding does not have to be repaid and may cover up to 85 per cent of eligible costs, to a maximum of \$25,000 per project.
- → The young entrepreneur must make a cash investment in the business equal to 10 per cent of the NOHFC's conditional contribution.
