
SOUTHWESTERN ONTARIO – MAP A

Size Limits

Unless otherwise stated, the length referred to is total length. (See page 4.)

Size restrictions listed above apply to both Sport Fishing and Conservation licences.

Daily Catch and Possession Limits

Daily catch and possession limits will depend on the type of fishing licence you hold, the species and where they are caught and in some cases the size of fish. The **catch** limit is the number of fish you are allowed to catch and keep in one day. The **possession** limit is the number you are allowed to have in your possession on hand, in cold storage, in transit, etc. Possession limits are the same as one day's catch limit except where otherwise specified.

Shore Meals - Fish caught that day and eaten are counted as part of your daily catch limit.

t Catch and Possession Limits for Salmon and Trout COMBINED

[Not exceeding individual species limits where otherwise stated]

- S Div. 1 (Lake St. Clair, St. Clair River and Detroit River) & Div. 2 (Lake Erie): five (5) salmon and trout in one day, but not more than three (3) may be lake trout, brook trout, and splake combined. In Lake Huron (Div. 35), not more than two (2) may be rainbow trout.
- Divs. 3, 4, & 5: five (5) salmon and trout in one day, but not more than two (2) may be lake trout. Divs. 3 & 4, see General Areas Exceptions for rainbow trout in tributaries to Lake Huron and Georgian Bay and lake trout in tributaries to Lake Ontario.
- Two (2) in one day but not more than one (1) may be lake trout. Lake Huron (Div. 35) not more than one (1) rainbow trout. Divs. 3 & 4, see General Areas Exceptions for rainbow trout in tributaries to Lake Huron and Georgian Bay.

General Notes

- The Talbot River and its tributaries and the Trent Canal System in Brock Twp., Durham Region and Ramara Twp., Simcoe County, are part of Div. 6.
- Sparrow Lake (Orillia and Morrison Twps.) is in Div. 4.
- The Niagara River upstream from Niagara Falls is in Div. 2.
- Severn River System in the Regional Municipality of Muskoka, including Gloucester Pool, is in Div. 4.
- Lake Simcoe is all of Div. 5. See exceptions for cisco (lake herring) season and limits.
- The Detroit River and St. Clair River are in Div. 1.

Recreational Fishing Regulations

Ontario's recreational fishing regulations have become complex over the past few decades. This makes the regulations very difficult to understand and a potential barrier to new anglers. To address this matter, the Ministry of Natural Resources has embarked on an initiative to simplify recreational fishing regulations and provide enhanced fishing opportunities across the province.

Over the next two years, the ministry will also be reviewing the fishing division boundaries and preparing guidelines for managing all the major recreational fish species in the province.

You will notice that the fishing regulation summary now covers two years, 2005 and 2006. This will assist us in preparing the new fishing divisions and streamlining the regulations in time for the 2007 summary. Please help reduce the environmental impact of printing this summary by keeping your copy until a new one is available in 2007.
