Abstract

A provincial survey was conducted to obtain information on competitive fishing activities which occurred in Ontario during 2004. Information on a total of 680 events is summarized. This represents a 31% increase from the number of events documented during a 1999 survey. The majority of events (61.8%) were situated on inland waters of southern Ontario followed by the Great Lakes (20.3%). Most events lasted only one day in duration. Fish and game clubs and professional tournament series accounted for the organization of 434 competitive fishing events (63.8%). Bass were the most commonly targeted species accounting for 42.6% of all events. Other popular species included walleye (13.3%) and northern pike (8.8%). Based on the results of this survey, several issues were identified and recommendations are offered for consideration. A similar survey should be conducted again in 2009.

Introduction

Competitive fishing has been broadly defined as "organized events in which a group of anglers fish for inducements such as awards, prizes or public recognition, in addition to the catch or the satisfaction of catching fish" (Schramm et al. 1991). This activity is increasing in popularity throughout North America (Kerr and Kamke 2003). Ontario currently ranks among the top jurisdictions in North American in terms of the number of competitive fishing activities held annually.

Ontario's policy on competitive fishing was developed in 1984 (see Table 1) and remains in effect today. As the number of competitive fishing events increased over the years several issues arose which resulted in policy reviews in 1994 and again in 2001. In 1996, the Kawartha Lakes Competitive Fishing Events Committee was formed. This group, comprised of tournament organizers, MNR staff, and conservation representatives, was established to deal with concerns associated with competitive fishing events in the Kawartha lakes region. In 1996, the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters developed a sanctioning policy for competitive fishing activities (Rose 1999). A provincial workshop, involving participants from government, tournament organizers, and interest groups, was held in March 1999 (Kerr 1999b). The first detailed survey of competitive fishing activities in Ontario was also conducted in 1999 (Kerr 1999a). An Ontario Competitive Fishing Council, comprised of tournament organizations, the sport fishing industry and public interest representatives, was formed in 2003. The Council was designed to provide information on competitive fishing to the public, develop best management practices for competitive fishing events, and address social issues as they arise.

Table 1. Highlights from Ontario's current policy on competitive fishing.

- MNR will discourage events perceived to have a detrimental impact.
- MNR staff will not act in a judicial capacity at a competitive fishing event.
- MNR will not tag fish for a competitive fishing event.
- Catch-and-release events will be encouraged.
- All relevant legislation will be enforced.
- Safety should be promoted at all competitive fishing events.
- MNR will not stock fish specifically for a competitive fishing event.

Since Ontario does not have any permitting or registration system for competitive fishing activities, Kerr (1999) recommended that provincial surveys be conducted on a regular basis in order to monitor the growth and characteristics of this industry. This report has been prepared to summarize the results of a 2004 survey of competitive fishing activities in the province of Ontario.

Survey Methods

Similar to the 1999 survey, a variety of sources were used to collect information on 2004 competitive fishing activities across the province. Sources included internet searches, information from field staff, notices in fishing magazines and related publications, schedules from tournament organizers, as well as material displayed at the Ontario Sportsman Show and the Spring Fishing Show in Toronto. A draft listing of events was sent to field staff, the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters, and the Canadian Sport Fishing Industry Association for review and input. Information was only included for events which were scheduled for the 2004 calendar year.

Results

Geographic Distribution of Events




Figure 1. Geographic distribution of competitive fishing events in Ontario during 2004. Areas are based on administrative units of the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources.

Information was obtained for 680 events. The geographic distribution of 2004 competitive fishing events in Ontario is illustrated in Figure 1. Inland waters of the province supported the majority of competitive fishing activity. These activities were predominantly located in southern Ontario.

Approximately twenty percent of events occurred on the Great Lakes (including Lake St. Clair and the Bay of Quinte). Lakes Erie, Ontario and St. Clair were the most frequently selected lakes. Two events were provincial in scope.

Several individual waters were heavily favored by tournament organizers (Table 2). Many of these same waters were identified during the 1999 survey.

Event Organizers

There are a wide variety of organizers of competitive fishing events in Ontario. In 2004 there was a dramatic increase in the proportion of events organized by local fish and game clubs. Many of these organizations use tournament to raise funds for local conservation programs. In other situations (e.g., Bassmasters events), events are largely organized as an activity for club members.

Many Conservation Authorities sponsor fishing events which are held at local conservation areas. Service clubs often utilize fishing events to raise money for charities and local projects.

A substantial number of events are also part of an organized fishing tournament series (Table 4). Many of these were identified during the 1999 survey but several new series (Strait Line Anglers Series, Ontario Chinese Anglers Fishing Series, Match Anglers of Ontario events, Kids,Cops and Canadian Tire, etc.) were identified.

Another observation worthy of note is the apparent increase in fishing events involving children (i.e., < 16 years of age). Many of these events were associated with the provincial "Family Fishing Weekend". Examples of events designed for children included "Bassin for Kids", Ducks Unlimited Greenwing Weekend, Future Champions Bass Tournaments, Kingston Kids Perch Derby, and the Kids, Cops, and Canadian Tire events. Several other tournaments also offered concurrent children's events.

Temporal Distribution of Events

Data on the timing of events was available for 640 of the 680 competitive events which were documented (Table 5). Approximately 65% of all events were held during the summer (i.e., June-August) period. A similar observation was reported during the 1999 survey (Kerr 1999). Only 6.2% of all events (N = 40) were held during the winter. This represents a decline from 12.2% of events recorded in the 1999 survey. December was the only month of the year when no competitive fishing events were reported.

Competitive events for some species had a distinct seasonal nature (Table 6). Bass events are conducted predominantly in the summer and early fall. There appears to be an increase in the number of bass events held during the fall. Events targeting crappies are conducted almost exclusively in the spring. Events on the Great Lakes involving Pacific salmon are generally held during the summer period.

There are some reasons for concern however. Practices associated with catch-andrelease walleye tournaments have a significant physiological effect on walleye (Killen et. al. 2003, Sobchuk and Dawson 1988). Many factors, including weather conditions, high winds, length of time in livewells, livewell holding densities, and weigh-in practices all influence mortality. There is also a higher risk of mortality associated with elevated water temperatures (Boland 1991, Fielder and Johnson 1994, Goeman 1991). Many North American jurisdictions avoid scheduling walleye tournaments during the hot summer months. Almost half (47.6%) of all walleye tournaments in Ontario occur during the summer however.

Duration of Events

Almost three-quarters of all competitive fishing events in 2004 lasted only one day in duration (Table 7). One hundred and forty-four events lasted two or more days while twenty-one events were seasonal (i.e., spring, summer, etc.) and one event lasted for the entire year.

Based on comparisons with previous surveys, there has been a trend to shorter (i.e., one day) events.

Long-Running Events

Although there has been a dramatic increase in the number of competitive fishing events in recent years, there are several annual events which have have been conducted over an extended period of time (Table 8).

Twenty-nine annual events exceeding ten years in duration were identified during this survey. In the 1999 survey, forty-two events exceeded ten years in length.

Information derived from annual fishing events can be used to monitor the status of local fisheries (Quertermus 1991, Cooke et al. 1998, MacMillan and McNeill undated). Data from these long-running events could prove useful to local fisheries managers.

Species Sought

Table 9 summarizes fish species which were targeted during competitive fishing activities in 2004. Numerous events identified more than one species. In these cases, all of the species identified were tabulated individually. In total, twenty-five different fish species were sought during 2004 competitive fishing activities in Ontario. In 1999, only eighteen different target species were identified.

Bass remain the top species sought by competitive anglers (42.6% of all events). This represents a modest increase from the 1999 survey. In a 1983 survey, Duttweiler (1985)

found that bass tournaments outnumbered competitive fishing for all other species by a factor of ten. Schramm et al. (1991) reported that bass accounted for 77.5% of events compiled during a 1989 survey of North American jurisdictions.

Walleye, northern pike and lake trout remain as popular species for competitive anglers but their proportions have all declined from 1999. Walleye account for a more significant proportion of targeted species in northwestern Ontario.

Discussion

Comparison with Earlier Surveys

To date, there have been three surveys of competitive fishing activities in Ontario. Although the 1989 survey (Schramm 1991) was not conducted to the same level of detail, it is interesting to compare results (Table 10).

There has been a dramatic increase in the number of events throughout the province over the past fifteen years. From 1999 to 2004, there has been a 31% increase in the number of events in Ontario. Similar trends have been noted in other North American jurisdictions (Schramm et al. 1991, Wilde 2003). There also appears to be a shift from longer (i.e., multi-day events) to shorter (i.e., one day) events.

Based on a recent survey of competitive fishing activities in other North American jurisdictions (Kerr and Kamke 2003), only seven other states (Conneticutt, Florida, Michigan, Missouri, Oklahoma, Tennessee and Texas) have more competitive fishing events on an annual basis than the province of Ontario.

The number of different species targeted by competitive fishing activities has also increased substantially. Twenty-five species were identified during the 2004 survey. The proportion of events seeking bass have increased during each survey to the point that, in 2004, they comprised 42.6% of Ontario events. Concurrent with this increase, the proportion of events seeking other popular species (e.g., walleye, northern pike, lake trout) have all declined.

Competitive Fishing Issues

Issues with respect to competitive fishing activities were reviewed in detail by Grant (1999). There continue to be concerns about the biological impacts of competitive fishing activities on local fisheries. These concerns predominantly include mortality of

tournament-caught fish (Goeman 1991, Hoffman et al. 1996, Taillon and McLeod 2004) and displacement of tournament-caught fish released at a central point some distance from their point of capture (Lantz and Carver 1975, Stang et al. 1996, Taillon and McLeod 2004). Social issues include crowding at access points, excessive boat traffic, and philosophical differences. From an enforcement perspective, compliance issues include culling/sorting of fish, disposal of dead fish, moving fish among waterbodies, and fishing prior to the season (Twiss and Chevalier 1999).

There are many positive aspects of competitive fishing. Events often have a substantial economic impact on local communities. Fishing tournaments also raise the profile of angling as an activity.

There needs to be a coordinated and concerted effort between government, sponsors, and tournament organizers to resolve issues which arise both at the local and provincial scale.

Recommendations

- Promote the use of new techniques (e.g., water weigh-in) to minimize handling and air exposure for tournament-caught fish. Wilde (1998) concluded that many organizers were not implementing new procedures designed to maximize survival. Recent research in Ontario (Tufts and Morlock 2004) has resulted in the development of new handling, weigh-in, and release procedures which should be implemented by tournament organizers across the province.
- 2. Encourage MNR field biologists to utilize large and long-running competitive fishing events as a source of biological information on local fisheries. There are several examples in North America whereby field biologists utilize fishing tournaments as a source to collect biological data (Olson and Cunningham 1989, Quertermus 1991, Cooke et al. 1998, Corbett 1999, Jackson 2000). During a recent survey of North American jurisdictions, however, Kerr and Kamke (2003) found that relatively few (21%) state or provincial fisheries staff regularly participate or use competitive fishing events as a source of information.
- 3. Work cooperatively with the Ontario Competitive Fishing Council to develop guidelines and best management practices for future events. A competitive fishing council is currently in the process of being established in Ontario. One of their objectives is to develop and encourage adherence to a code of conduct regarding acceptable standards for the operation of competitive fishing events across the province. The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources should assist this council in the development of sound, biologically-based guidelines and best management practices as soon as possible. Guidelines for competitive fishing events should recognize physiological differences among fish species as well as variations in practices at different types of events.

- 4. Discourage events for walleye and northern pike during the hot weather of summer (i.e., mid June-August). There are several studies (Goeman 1991, Fielder and Johnson 1994, Hoffman et al. 1996) which have indicated that mortality rates of some species, such as walleye, are elevated during hotter temperatures (i.e., > 15-20° C) of summer. Many North American jurisdictions already prohibit live release walleye events during the summer. Organizers of walleye events in Ontario should be encouraged to avoid mid-summer events.
- 5. Discourage competitive fishing events which target native lake trout and brook trout stocks in inland waters. Brook trout and lake trout inhabit relatively unproductive oligotrophic waters and cannot withstand heavy angling pressure. In addition they are both sensitve to hooking mortality and capture from deep water. Organizers of events targeting these species should be encouraged to shift competitive events to other more abundant and resilient species of fish.
