PRE-HEARING AND POST-HEARING PROCEDURE ON APPLICATION TO REMOVE A CAUTION

TO:

ALL LAND REGISTRARS

THE LAND TITLES ACT, SECTION 144

Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations

The following procedure should be followed when an application to remove a caution has been received from the registered owner:

- 1. The application must be accompanied by the proper fee, which is currently \$10.00 for the application (plus \$2.00 for each additional parcel affected), \$5.00 for the Order that will be given by the Land Registrar or Director of Titles, \$1.00 for each notice to be issued by the Land Registrar and an additional fee for the actual cost of service of each notice by registered mail.
- 2. The application should be given a registration number and its particulars entered on the parcel register, as set out in Examples 1 and 1A appearing at the end of this Bulletin.
- Subsequent to the holding of the hearing, the 3. Order of the Land Registrar or the Director of Titles, as the case may be, should be registered after the appeal period has expired (providing no notice of appeal has been received). If the Order directs that the caution be deleted, the Land Registrar should strike the caution and the application to remove the caution from the parcel register and reflect his authority for so doing by way of marginal note below the entry of the caution, and below the entry of the Application to remove the caution. If the Order directs Examples 2 and 2A). that the caution remain on title, then only the application to remove the caution should be deleted, and a corresponding marginal note should be made below such deletion. Examples 3 and 3A). If the Order has been

appealed no entry should be made on the parcel register until the appeal has been finally disposed of. The time limit for an appeal from an Order of the Land Registrar or Director of Titles is within 15 days after the date of such order. Accordingly, the Land Registrar should endeavour to serve his Order on the same day that the Order is dated and signed.
