## BRIEF OVERVIEW

The Legal Services Branch provides strategic legal advice to the Ministries of Citizenship & Immigration, Culture, Tourism and Recreation, selected agencies, the Ontario Seniors' Secretariat and the Ontario Women's Directorate in support of their policy, legislative and operational objectives.

Branch counsel provide legal opinions, draft legal documentation and participate in staff training programs. Branch staff also draft bills, regulations and orders-in council in accordance with the government's policy agenda.

Legal services are provided in the areas of corporate and commercial law, real property law, administrative law, intellectual property law, legislative interpretation, privacy law and crown law.

## DESCRIPTION OF ARTICLING PROGRAM

Students will undertake legal research and opinion work and may assist in drafting legislation, Ministers' orders, contracts and other legal documents. They also review commercial documentation, conduct corporate searches and investigate titles.
