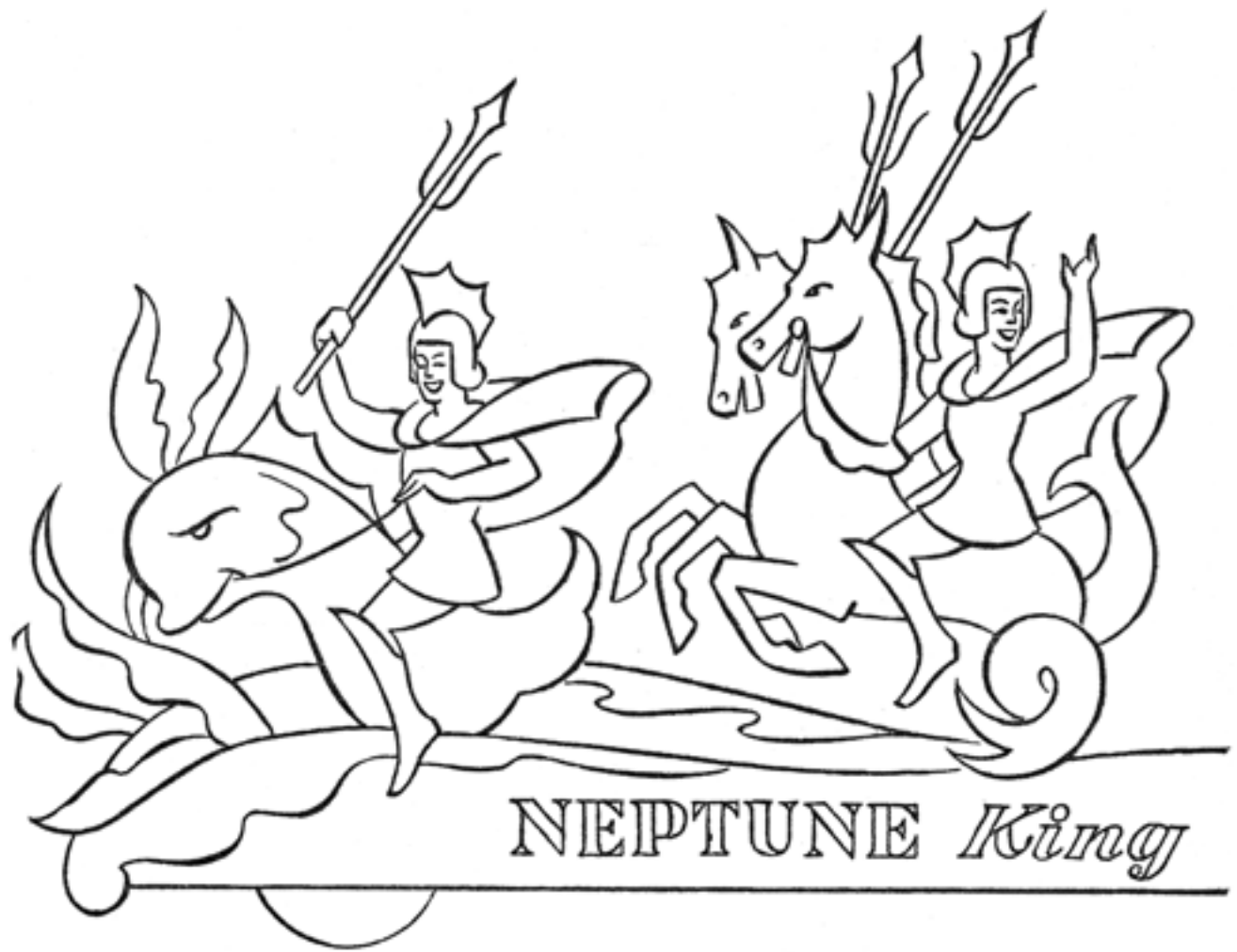
Here comes
