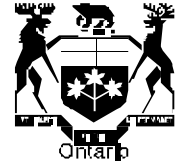

Re: **Setting Payment Amounts for Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s Prescribed Generation Assets Activities Eligible for Cost Awards**

On March 21, 2006, the Board issued a letter to interested parties identifying the regulatory process to be used in setting payment amounts for Ontario Generation Inc.'s prescribed generation assets. That letter also indicated that the Board would make cost awards available to eligible persons in relation to their participation in this process and that any costs awarded would be recovered from OPG. By Order dated May 18, 2006, the Board determined that seven participants are eligible for cost awards in relation to this process.

In Appendix A to its March 21, 2006 letter, the Board identified the activities that would be eligible for cost awards but left open the issue of the quantum of costs for preparation time in advance of meetings scheduled with Board staff to discuss the first and second drafts of Board staff's Discussion Paper. The Board wishes to advise participants in this proceeding that participants eligible for cost awards may claim up to 10 hours for preparation and reporting time in relation to the meetings held to discuss the drafts of Board staff's Discussion Paper, in addition to time spent at the meetings. The Board confirms that cost awards will also be available in relation to written submissions on the final draft of Board staff's Discussion Paper, to a maximum of 21 hours.
