
ONTARIO'S WAIT TIMES: TRENDS GOING IN RIGHT DIRECTION

Ontario has been collecting and posting wait times for five key services – cancer surgery, cardiac procedures, cataract surgery, hip and knee replacement and MRI and CT scans – on a public web site www.ontariowaittimes.com. The graphs below show the province-wide trends for each procedure, comparing the most current median wait times data (Dec.'05/Jan.06) with the baseline of when we began to compile comprehensive data (Aug./Sept.'05).



Cataract Surgery Provincial Wait Times





Total Knee Replacement Provincial Wait Times




