King currently serves as volunteer and chairperson for the New Credit Public Library and chairs the New Credit Cultural Committee. From 1997 to 1999, she was elected chief of Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation Council. She is a volunteer board member of the Toronto Historical Association and a member of the Council for the Advancement of Native Economic Development Officers.
