## IMPROVING ACCESS TO FIVE KEY HEALTHCARE SURGERIES AND PROCEDURES

The McGuinty government is improving access to five key health care services as part of its Wait Time Strategy. This year the government is targeting funding through the Wait Times Strategy to deliver:

- 4,300 more total hip and knee joint replacements than last year for a total of 6,700 this year.
- 14,000 additional cataract surgeries than last year for a total of 16,000 surgeries.
- 39,500 additional MRI exams than last year for a total of 58,500 exams. This is in addition to the 37,260 more exams for 2005/2006 from last year's investment in 7 replacement MRI machines, the new hospital MRI machines and expanded hours of operation at the repatriated MRIs in Independent Health Facilities, for a total increase in MRI exams of 24 per cent this year.
- 2,900 additional cancer surgeries than last year for a total 4,800 surgeries.
- 7,000 more cardiac procedures than last year.

Listed below is a breakdown of the funding for the entire year's allocation for extra cancer surgeries and cardiac procedures, as well as the first six months of extra hip and knee replacements, cataract surgeries, and extended MRI hours. The second phase of allocations for hip and knee, cataracts and MRIs will be announced this fall, allowing improved accountability as well as additional information to be gathered in order to better target resources to have maximum impact on wait times.
