Physician Re-Entry Program

Beginning in November 2006, the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care will accept applications for the Physician Re-Entry program, for ministry-funded training positions beginning in 2007. Available positions include several **new opportunities** and provide:

- Increased choice in training opportunities
 - All specialties* (20 positions) and subspecialties* (5 positions);
 - Skills enhancement opportunities for family practitioners
 - Third year family medicine and family medicine residency (20 positions);
- A variety of learning opportunities in Community medicine

 Community medicine specialty or Masters of public health programs* (5 positions).

*New opportunities for 2006/07

To be eligible you must:

- Hold a current certificate of registration for independent practice from your provincial College of Physicians and Surgeons
- Have been in active, full time practice in Canada for a minimum of 6 consecutive months prior to application
- Be eligible for a certificate of registration from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario
- Be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent resident of Canada

Physicians accepted to the program may attend the Ontario medical school of their choice, conditional upon acceptance by the school.

Physicians accepted for a re-entry training position must commit to providing full-time service in an underserviced community, acceptable to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, upon completion of training. Return of Service (ROS) requirements for certain positions may differ; please refer to the 2007 Re-Entry Program Information Letter for detailed information.
