# Being Properly Prepared to Find the Right Job for You

Are you looking to re-enter the labour force? If you are eligible for the Job Readiness measure, you can participate in a project that will help you

- develop the personal skills needed to find a job or stay employed;
- gain a better understanding of the labour market;
- conduct a job search;
- do an internship;
- acquire production-related work experience (in job integration companies).

#### You are eligible if

you receive Employment Insurance benefits;

you receive employment-assistance benefits;

you are unemployed and do not receive public income support;

you are someone who experiences major difficulties trying to find and retain employment.

## Participation time

Average of 20 hours per week.

## Duration of assistance

Assistance may be provided for several weeks.
