

Who needs a guarantor?

A guarantor's declaration is required if you cannot provide **photo ID**.

Who can be a guarantor?

The guarantor confirms the applicant's identity. The guarantor must be a Canadian citizen and have known the applicant for at least two years under the identity indicated on the application. Eligible guarantors are listed below.

Eligible Guarantors

- Member of the National Assembly of Québec
- Member of the Parliament of Canada
- Judge at a court of law
- Mayor
- Municipal councillor
- Borough councillor
- Member of a professional corporation for an exclusive profession (**see list below**)
- Executive director of a healthcare institution
- Executive director of a social service institution
- Principal of a primary or secondary school or director of a CEGEP
- Head of a private educational institution recognized by the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport
- Rector or dean of a Québec university
- Member of a police force
- A local registration officer or other public servant named as such under laws pertaining to the Cree, Inuit, or Kaskapi Natives for members of these communities
