

Hospitality policy for international organizations

Some 72 international organizations have chosen Montréal, Québec City, Sherbrooke, Trois-Rivières or la Gaspésie either to set up representation offices or their head office. Fields of activity vary widely, from high technology and sport to transport and the environment.

Funding of these international organizations is mainly from foreign sources and the economic spin-off from their presence in Québec is highly significant. Spending carried out by these organizations is in the order of approximately \$300 million per year, and they directly create and maintain a total of almost 1,7000 jobs. These international organizations also have a highly significant effect on the number of international activities that take place in Québec.

International governmental organizations

An international governmental organization (IGO) is defined as an association of States constituted by means of a treaty and having a constitution and common organs, being also equipped with a distinct legal identity from that of its member States. When the Government of Québec is host to an international governmental organization (IGO), it grants, **by agreement**, tax benefits and jurisdictional immunities to said organization and its employees, and also agrees to a whole set of courtesy measures in accordance with international practices.

For an international governmental organization, eligibility requirements to be accepted under the hospitality policy are as follows:

- It must have an international legal identity;
- It must intend setting up its head office or one of its offices in Québec;
- It must carry out its activities in a field that is in line with the interests of Québec.

International and non-governmental organizations (NGOs)

International non-governmental organizations (NGOs) refers to an institution that has been created by a mixed private interest, free from any intergovernmental agreement, made up of private or public institutions or individuals of various nationalities. **By agreement**, the Government of Québec grants **international non-governmental organizations (NGOs)** tax exemptions and certain other benefits when they meet strict criteria and operate in areas that form part of Québec's priorities. These benefits, which are offered to organizations and their non-Canadian employees, can include areas such as health (health insurance and hospital provisions), immigration, education and driving permits.

In order to benefit from the various advantages of Québec's hospitality policy, international and non-governmental organizations must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- They must already or plan in future to exercise their activity in areas that are in line with the priorities of Québec society;
- Their objectives and regulations must be compatible with Québec's Charter of Human Rights and Freedoms;
- They must be representative in nature and their basic purpose must be recognized internationally;
- They must have a recognized head office with a chief administrator. Their constitutions must have been adopted according to democratic principles;
- They must be in a position to speak on behalf of their members through means of authorized representatives;
- They must have an international structure and their members must have the right to take part in decisions that affect policy and action;

- Their main resources must come from contributions from their national sections or from individual members.

Priority areas

The Government of Québec particularly encourages international organizations from the following fields to set up in the province:

- Priority areas:
 - Economic activity, especially financial services;
 - Science and technology, including aerospace and aeronautics;
 - Telecommunications;
 - Computing;
 - Information technologies;
 - High technology.
- La Francophonie and its priority areas of activity:
 - Agriculture and the environment;
 - Energy;
 - Culture and communications;
 - Scientific information and technology;
 - Language industries.
- International development
- Humanitarian aid
- Human rights
