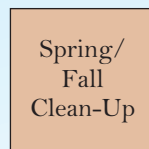
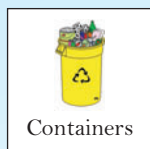

Set Out	<p>All material must be set out for collection by 5:00 a.m. Material must be placed 5 to 6 feet (1.5 to 1.6 m) from the curb or roadside (in driveway, not on sidewalk or snow bank). Green cart must have at least a foot clearance around it to allow for proper collection and with wheels facing away from the road. Containers (except for the green cart) cannot exceed 23 kg (50lbs).</p>
Green Cart	<p>What can I compost? (Green carts are collected the same day as paper)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO PLASTICS of any kind including biodegradable plastic • All table scraps • Cooking oil, grease, fat (solidified) • Soiled pizza boxes • Meat, chicken, fish, bones • Fruit & vegetable peelings, egg & nut shells • Bread, rice, pasta, dairy products, cheese • Microwavable popcorn bags • Waxed corrugated cardboard • Disposable paper coffee cups • Coffee grounds & filters, tea leaves & bags • Soiled paper (including cardboard, napkins, towels, plates, cups, tissues & waxed paper) • Leaf and Yard Waste (L&YW - leaves, plant trimmings) <p>Extra L&YW CAN ONLY be placed out for collection when the L&YW symbol appears on your collection day. See Leaf and Yard Waste section for more information.</p> <p>To absorb moisture and reduce odours, layer DRY L&YW over wet food waste and place balled up paper at the bottom of the cart. Organic material can also be wrapped in newspaper or paper bags.</p>
Paper	<p>What can I recycle? (Paper is collected the same day as your green cart)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boxboard (cereal, tissue, cracker boxes) • Catalogues & magazines • Corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags • Hard and soft cover books • Newspaper and flyers • Paper egg cartons & trays • Phone books • Writing paper and envelopes • Greeting cards <p>Material must be placed loose in a blue box, cardboard box, paper bag or other reusable container. Paper in plastic bags WILL NOT be collected (Shredded paper in clear plastic bags IS ACCEPTABLE).</p>
Containers	<p>What can I recycle? (Containers are collected the same day as regular garbage)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Empty, dry paint cans (lids removed) • Empty aerosol cans • Glass bottles and jars (lids removed) • Cartons (milk, juice, cream) • Drink boxes • Plastic Bags: bread, milk, sandwich, frozen food, dry cleaning and grocery (stuff plastic bags into another plastic bag). • Aluminum plates, cans and foil • Small scrap metal items (utensils, pots & pans, baking sheets, metal coat hangers, etc.). Must fit inside your Triple R Can • Plastic food and beverage containers with symbols (#1-7) • Styrofoam products (plates, cups, meat trays, egg cartons, packaging for TVs, computers) • Steel cans <p>Empty containers must be placed loose in the Yellow Triple R Can or a re-usable container. Please rinse & remove all lids. Recyclables in plastic bags WILL NOT be collected.</p>
Garbage	<p>What goes in regular garbage? Not much once you recycle and compost! (Garbage is collected the same day as containers) 4 BAG LIMIT per household.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Broken ceramics and window glass (must be safely packaged in a cardboard box or rigid container) • Styrofoam packing popcorn • Feminine hygiene products & diapers • Dog & cat food bags • Cold ashes (must be in a combustible container-cardboard box, paper or plastic bag) • Toothpaste tubes • Kitty litter & animal feces • Chip bags & candy wrappers • Wrapping and tissue paper • Cereal box liner & cookie bag • Light bulbs (incandescent) • Old shoes • Empty oil containers • Cardboard tubes with metal ends (frozen juice, peanuts, hot chocolate) • Shrinkwrap and Bubblewrap • Vacuum cleaner bags

Christmas Tree Pick-Up	<div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;">  <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>Christmas Trees will be collected on January 19th, 2006 for Thursday residents and January 20th, 2006 for Friday residents. Christmas Trees must be free of stands, lights, ornaments, and tinsel. Christmas Trees in plastic bags or artificial trees WILL NOT be collected. Please place your tree out the NIGHT BEFORE collection to avoid the tree from becoming frozen in the snow and ice. Trees should not exceed 6 ft (19.98 m) in length.</p> </div>  </div>				
Fall / Spring Clean-Up	<p>All acceptable household items must be placed curbside on the SUNDAY NIGHT before your collection week. Trucks will only pick-up acceptable items ONCE during your collection week. Scrap metal collected by a separate truck. L&YW in plastic bags will not be collected. </p> <p>GUIDELINES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • use open top, rigid, reusable containers, cardboard boxes or paper yard waste bags • bundled brush and twigs cannot exceed 4 ft (1.2 m) in length and 1.5 ft (0.45 m) in diameter • individual branches must not exceed 1 inch (2.54 cm) in diameter (approx. thumb thickness) • individual bag/bundle/container must not exceed 50 lbs (23 kg) <p>ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Leaves, branches/brush, garden/hedge/tree trimmings, house & garden plants.
