Pembroke Waste Management Programs

All material must be set out for collection by 5:00 a.m. Material must be placed 5 to 6 feet (1.5 to Set Out 1.6 m) from the curb or roadside (in driveway, not on sidewalk or snow bank). Green cart must have at least a foot clearance around it to allow for proper collection and with wheels facing away from the road. Containers (except for the green cart) cannot exceed 23 kg (50lbs). What can I compost? (Green carts are collected the same day as paper) NO PLASTICS of any kind including Microwavable popcorn bags biodegradable plastic Waxed corrugated cardboard All table scraps Disposable paper coffee cups **Green Cart** Cooking oil, grease, fat (solidified) Coffee grounds & filters, tea leaves & bags Soiled pizza boxes Soiled paper (including cardboard, napkins, Meat, chicken, fish, bones towels, plates, cups, tissues & waxed paper) Fruit & vegetable peelings, egg & nut shells Leaf and Yard Waste (L&YW - leaves, plant Bread, rice, pasta, dairy products, cheese trimmings) Extra L&YW CAN ONLY be placed out for collection when the L&YW symbol appears on your collection day. See Leaf and Yard Waste section for more information. To absorb moisture and reduce odours, layer DRY L&YW over wet food waste and place balled up paper at the bottom of the cart. Organic material can also be wrapped in newspaper or paper bags. What can I recycle? (Paper is collected the same day as your green cart) Boxboard (cereal, tissue, cracker boxes) Paper egg cartons & travs Catalogues & magazines Phone books Corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags Writing paper and envelopes Greeting cards Hard and soft cover books Newspaper and flyers Material must be placed loose in a blue box, cardboard box, paper bag or other reusable container. Paper in plastic bags WILL NOT be collected (Shredded paper in clear plastic bags IS ACCEPTABLE). What can I recycle? (Containers are collected the same day as regular garbage) Empty, dry paint cans (lids removed) Small scrap metal items (utensils, pots & pans, baking sheets, metal coat hangers, etc.). Must Empty aerosol cans Glass bottles and jars (lids removed) fit inside your Triple R Can Containers Cartons (milk, juice, cream) Plastic food and beverage containers with Drink boxes symbols (#1-7) Plastic Bags: bread, milk, sandwich, frozen Styrofoam products (plates, cups, meat trays, food, dry cleaning and grocery (stuff plastic egg cartons, packaging for TVs, computers) bags into another plastic bag). Steel cans Aluminum plates, cans and foil Empty containers must be placed loose in the Yellow Triple R Can or a re-usable container. Please rinse & remove all lids. Recyclables in plastic bags WILL NOT be collected. What goes in regular garbage? Not much once you recycle and compost! (Garbage is collected the same day as containers) 4 BAG LIMIT per household. Broken ceramics and window glass (must be Chip bags & candy wrappers safely packaged in a cardboard box or rigid Wrapping and tissue paper Cereal box liner & cookie bag container) Styrofoam packing popcorn Light bulbs (incandescent) Feminine hygiene products & diapers Old shoes Dog & cat food bags Empty oil containers Cold ashes (must be in a combustible Cardboard tubes with metal ends

Tree Pick-Up Christmas



Christmas Trees will be collected on January 19th, 2006 for Thursday residents and January 20th, 2006 for Friday residents. Christmas Trees must be free of stands, lights, ornaments, and tinsel. Christmas Trees in plastic bags or artificial trees WILL NOT be collected. Please place your tree out the NIGHT **BEFORE** collection to avoid the tree from becoming frozen in the snow and ice. Trees should not exceed 6 ft (19.98 m) in length.



Fall / Spring Clean-Up

All acceptable household items must be placed curbside on the SUNDAY NIGHT before your collection week. Trucks will only pick-up acceptable items **ONCE** during your collection week. Scrap metal collected by a separate truck. Please ensure all fluids and gasoline are removed (i.e. lawn mower).

ACCEPTABLE

Appliances (stove, washer, dryer, fridge, freezer) Boxspring/Mattresses Broken window glass (safely packaged) Furniture, Mats, Carpet Toys Scrap Metal (please keep in separate pile)

NOT ACCEPTABLE

HHW (paints, batteries, oil, etc.) **Construction & Demolition Material** (drywall, shingles, wood, etc.) Leaf and Yard Waste Propane Tanks, Tires NO REGULAR GARBAGE

Material must not exceed 80lbs. (36.28 kg), 27 ft.3 (76m3) or 6 ft (19.68 m) and must be manageable by two (2) men. Material must be properly bundled or packaged in a container with sufficient strength.

Hazardous Waste (HHW) Household

HHW Depot

Located at the Ottawa Valley Waste Recovery Centre HHW accepted year round during normal operating hours (see below)

HHW Mobile Depots

Open 9:00 am to 3:00 pm Petawawa Civic Centre - May 28 KI Pembroke Parking Lot - June 25 Eganville Legion Field - July 23

Material accepted FREE OF CHARGE: paints, oils, oil filters, batteries, propane cylinders, used needles and lancets (properly packaged), pesticides and herbicides, florescent light bulbs. Containers must be 20L (5 gallon) or smaller.

This material IS NOT collected at your curb. Commercial and Industrial waste not accepted.

Leaf and Yard Naste (L&YW)

L&YW is acceptable in the green cart. Extra L&YW will ONLY be collected on the days shown on your collection day. Check your schedule for the L&YW symbol. L&YW in plastic bags will not be collected.



GUIDELINES: • use open top, rigid, reusable containers, cardboard boxes or paper yard waste bags

- bundled brush and twigs cannot exceed 4 ft (1.2 m) in length and 1.5 ft (0.45 m) in
- individual branches must not exceed 1 inch (2.54 cm) in diameter (approx. thumb thickness)
- individual bag/bundle/container must not exceed 50 lbs (23 kg)

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Leaves, branches/brush, garden/hedge/tree trimmings, house & garden plants. Residential L&YW is also accepted at the OVWRC free of charge (NO PLASTIC).
