WARNING FOR TRUCKERS WHO TAKE ROUTE 175 THROUGH THE LAURENTIAN WILDLIFE RESERVE

As a result of the work that is underway on Route 175 in the Laurentian wildlife reserve, the roadway is **only 4 metres wide** in some places. This limitation may create a hindrance to truckers in some areas, and may present a problem for some vehicles that are less than 4 metres wide. Depending on the type of truck, the speed of the traffic, and the geometry of the road, it is important to have the minimum clearance on each side of the vehicle, and to take into consideration wheel slippage at curves, in order to ensure the safe passage of oversized trucks.

The Ministère des Transports du Québec stresses that special permit holders who drive oversized trucks (i.e.: more than 2.6 m wide) should call the Saguenay regional information and communication centre (CRIC) at 418-698-3570 **before taking Route 175 between Québec City and Saguenay.** This will give you access to the latest information concerning width restrictions, in order to avoid setbacks and to ensure your own safety and that of other road users.
