HEAVY VEHICLE TRAFFIC

THE APPLICATION, STARTING MAY 29, 1998, OF REGULATIONS GOVERNING TRAFFIC ON ROADS CLOSED TO TRUCKS

We wish to notify all truck drivers that as of May 29, 1998 the regulations governing traffic on roads closed to trucks and special mobile equipment will be fully enforced by police forces and highway transportation controllers.

The folder entitled *SIGNS ON ROADS CLOSED TO TRUCKS* was designed to help truck drivers better understand the road signs used in these regulations. We suggest that you obtain a copy of it from the department's territorial division in your region and keep it in your vehicle for consultation when necessary.

HOME BASE

As regards the exception of driving a vehicle to its home base, we would like to make the following clarification:

The prohibitory sign Excepté livraison locale authorizes truck drivers to travel on roads closed to trucks and special mobile equipment if they are making a local delivery in order to:



- pick up or deliver a good;
- provide a service;
- perform a job;
- have the vehicle repaired;
- drive the vehicle to its home base.
