INSTRUCTIONS FOR CITES APPLICATIONS:

It is recommended that a separate CITES application be submitted for each hunter.

Section 4: Identify if the wildlife is for **personal use**, (e.g. hunting trophy), or for **commercial use** (e.g. resale). Fees are \$30 for personal use and \$55 for commercial use. Payment by cheque or money order must be payable to **Minister of Finance**. Attach credit card authorization sheet if paying by credit card.

Section 5: Please allow 5 business days for a permit, plus time for mailing. In case of an emergency, permits can usually be expedited. Please call the Bureau at 1-866-433-7272-2-1 to make arrangements.

Section 7, 8: Species for which the Ministry of Environment provides CITES are:

- Black bear can be exported by Americans into the USA without a CITES permit within 30 days of the harvest. The non-resident hunting licence and non-resident species licence must accompany the wildlife.

Description: Includes the number of animals (e.g., Two (2) lynx), whether live, whether salted or tanned hide, whether a rug or mounted, whether garment, carving, boiled and bleached skull, etc., and if black bear, whether paws are attached.

Documentation: Must include one of:

- 1) The hunter's non-resident licence number and the non-resident species licence number or resident hunter number and the resident species licence number or the Trapper's Licence Number, under which the item was taken, and for compulsory inspected species, include the compulsory inspection number.
- 2) A Possession Permit number, or the item's receipt number and bar code from the BC Government Asset Recovery Branch wildlife auction, or the applicant's Fur Trader Licence number.
- 3) If the species is a Polar Bear, an import permit issued under the Marine Mammal Protection Act is required if wildlife is being exported to the USA. Please contact the US Office of Management Authority at 703-358-2104.

The application must include the Nunavut or Northwest Territories quota number or species licence number. A copy of the provincial or territorial Wildlife export permit under which the specimen came into BC must be attached.

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
