When original documentation has been lost, a Statutory Declaration must be sworn and attached to a Wildlife Act Permit Application for a Possession Permit before an Export permit is issued. If your application involves live wildlife or viable eggs you must include a detailed safety plan showing how public safety will be protected (i.e., how would you prevent escapes?), describe the purpose of this activity and any special circumstances the Ministry should be aware of. Note: Falconry-related applications are exempt from the requirement to provide a safety plan. NOTE: Permits cannot be issued for activities that are contrary to the proper management of wildlife in B.C. (Permit Regulation, B.C. Reg. 253/2000, s. 5).
