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HOW INDIVIDUALS CAN HELP

The Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) recommends that individuals wishing to help in this time of need make donations to well-established and experienced relief agencies. The donation of money, rather than goods, is the most effective way to help as it allows experienced organizations to make the best use of each dollar donated. Individuals wishing to make a financial donation may contact CIDA recommended Canadian non-governmental organizations responding to the crisis in the region.

The Canadian Red Cross

Canadians wishing to make a financial donation may donate online at <u>http://www.redcross.ca/</u>, call tollfree 1-800-418-1111 or contact their local Canadian Red Cross office. The 24-hour line accepts Visa and MasterCard. Cheques should be made payable to the Canadian Red Cross, earmarked "South East Asia Earthquake and Tidal Wave Relief" and mailed to Canadian Red Cross National Office, 170 Metcalfe Street, Suite 300, Ottawa, Ontario, K2P 2P2. Donations of goods are not accepted.
