Comment Invited on Draft Terms of Reference for BCTC's Application for an Environmental Assessment Certificate

British Columbia Transmission Corporation (BCTC) is a provincial Crown corporation responsible for managing, operating, and maintaining most of the provincial power transmission system and its interconnections with the larger North American grid. In order to meet current and projected electricity demand on Vancouver Island and to maintain reliable grid operations, BCTC is proposing to replace and upgrade the two existing 138 kV overhead transmission lines and submarine cables (1L17/1L18) connecting southern Vancouver Island, Salt Spring Island and Galiano Island to the Lower Mainland with two new 230 kV transmission lines.

The Vancouver Island Transmission Reinforcement Project is subject to review under British Columbia's Environmental Assessment Act, S.B.C.2002, c.43. As part of the review process, BCTC's Draft Terms of Reference for an Environmental Assessment Certificate application (Application) are being made available for public comment. The purpose of the Terms of Reference is to identify the information that must be included in BCTC's Application. Approved Terms of Reference will be issued by the Environmental Assessment Office following consideration of comments on the Draft Terms of Reference. BCTC will then be required to prepare its Application in accordance with the Approved Terms of Reference.
