REVIEW OF SPECIALTY PRODUCTION AND NEW ENTRANT PROGRAMS – IMPROVING ACCESS TO THE SUPPLY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

I am writing to follow up regarding the meeting on July 26, 2006, between Richard Bullock, Ron Charles and ourselves. One of the issues discussed at that time was an amendment to the General Orders of the British Columbia Turkey Marketing Board as directed by the British Columbia Farm Industry Review Board (FIRB) on June 26, 2006.

You requested clarification concerning the effective date of the application of the declining assessment (10/10/10 rule) to increases in turkey allocation. FIRB has considered the matter and the members have confirmed their intent that this provision should be applied to turkey quota or allocation issued on and after May 1, 2006.
