Road right-of-ways are defined as three metres (10 feet) beyond the edge of the ditch or excavated portion of the road bank or fill slope. | |
| 2. Trees may NOT be cut from: a. Private lands (without permission of the private landowner) or other areas alienated or resert for a special use; b. Woodlot Licence areas; c. Parks; d. Forest plantations in harvested areas; e. Research areas; f. Areas within 50 meters from any stream. | ved |
