#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 18 Jan 06, Barriere SAR responded to assist BCAS with a person trapped under a tractor.

On 21 Jan 06, 2 people were provided with accommodation when they were evacuated from their residence due to a police investigation.

#### **BODY RECOVERY**

On 17 Jan 06, Hope SAR responded to assist the RCMP with a body recovery on Hwy 5 near the snow shed.

On 21 Jan 06, Kamloops SAR responded to conduct a body recovery in the Dallas Drive area near Pat Road.

#### **FLOOD**

On 16 Jan 06, sandbags were provided to residents on Rondeault Rd in Cowichan Bay to prevent flooding of the homes after water migrated across farm and park land due to heavy ground saturation. Emergency Program Coordinator and Fire Dept responded to the scene.
