A group of 7 people attempted to cross the Glacier from Tulsequah to Atlin over the ice field. A group of 4 decided against it and turned back while the other 3 forged ahead. CASARA, JRCC, the American Coast Guard and convergent volunteers were sourced to access the remote area in extreme winter condition over the glacier. Radio contact was made and during a window of opportunity a private helicopter was able to land and successfully rescue the subjects from the glacier.
