WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT – 27 MAR TO 02 APR 06

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 31 Mar 06, Teck Cominco reported a possible mercury release into the Columbia River at Trail had occurred over a 24 hour period. There was no mercury release into the plant and the source appeared to be from the re-mobilization of the sludge materials in the effluent treatment system. Due to potential for cross-border impact the incident was raised to Code 2 Urgent status by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer and Washington State Emergency Measures Organization was subsequently notified. Analysis of samples collected at Teck Cominco's Waneta station approximately 10 km downstream on the Columbia River near the US border indicated less than .00005 ml/g (milliliters per gallon) and the plant was re-started on 01 Apr 06. Subsequent samples indicated well within permit levels. Ministry of Environment Headquarters, Environment Canada, PEP Region Manager, Emergency Program Coordinator for the East Kootenay Regional District, Interior Health Authority and Ministry of Mines, Energy and Resources, were advised and monitored the situation.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 27 Mar 06, Vernon SAR were requested by the RCMP to conduct an evidence search near the Killiney Beach Estates. 9 Vernon SAR members responded.
