BODY RECOVERY

On 24 Apr 06, Hope SAR responded to recover a body in Kawkwa Lake. The body was recovered and turned over to the custody of the Coroner.

On 29 Apr 06, Castlegar SAR were called out to recover a body from an area just north of Syringa Provincial Park. The body was recovered and turned over to the custody of the Coroner.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 26 Apr 06, North Shore Rescue conducted an evidence search in North Vancouver.

On 27 Apr 06, Sunshine Coast SAR conducted an evidence search in Tuwanek, north of Sechelt.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 30 Apr 06 RCMP requested SAR assistance with the rescue of a stranded dog from Pulpit Rock in Nelson. The Nelson Rope Rescue team successfully rescued the dog from the ledge.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 28 Apr 06 the NEA PREOC activated to level 1 to lend support to the local government in Chetwynd when 2 forest fires started in the regional district around the town. The weather conditions were such that there was the risk that the fires could interface with a residential area. Ministry of Forests fire crews responded and with the weather conditions in their favour they were able to get control of the fires.
