BODY RECOVERY

On 02 May 06, Alberni Valley Rescue and Arrowsmith SAR members responded to assist with a body recovery at Cameron Lake after a vehicle went into the lake trapping one person.

On 07 May 06, North Cowichan/Duncan SAR members responded to assist with a body recovery by the Cowichan River in Duncan.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 07 May 06, Squamish SAR members responded to assist the RCMP with an evidence search over an embankment on the Mamquam Forest Service Road.

FLOOD

On 01 May 06, Kimberley Creek jumped its banks and flooded the basements of a number of homes in the Morrison Subdivision. The City of Kimberley put several gravel truck loads of material along the creek to maintain the integrity of the channel and a pump was brought in to move some of the water away from the area. The SEA Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre provided support to the Kimberley Emergency Operations Centre.
