AIR CRASH

On 11 May 06, Kamloops Fire Dept were dispatched to the scene of a small plane that had crashed near the Knutsford Airport. The fire crew was stood down on scene as their assistance was not required.

BODY RECOVERY

On 10 May 06, 14 members of Vernon SAR responded to assist the Coroner to recover a body in Kalamalka Park.

On 13 May 06, 4 Fernie SAR members were flown into the Three Sister Mountain area to recover the body of a deceased snowmobiler.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 08 May 06, members from Fort Nelson and North Peace SAR teams were transported by PEP Air to a camp 120 km SW of Fort Nelson to conduct an evidence search.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 10 May 06, Vancouver ESS volunteers responded to assist upwards of 10 apartment residents who were temporarily evacuated from their homes due to a police investigation.
