**BODY RECOVERY**

On 06 June 06, the Penticton Fire Department responded to investigate a report of a body floating in Skaha Lake. A body was located and recovered from the lake and turned over to the Coroner.

**EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 07 Jun 06, Central Fraser Valley SAR members were requested by the RCMP to conduct a search for evidence in an area of Abbotsford.

**INTERFACE FIRE**

On 09 Jun 06, an interface forest fire was burning in the Copperville Estates area of the Kitimat-Stikine Regional District. Forestry conducted a tactical evacuation of seven residences due to potential for rock fall resulting from fire fighting activities on the mountainside. Emergency Social Services activated a reception centre for the displaced residents. The NWE Provincial Regional Operations Centre (PREOC) was activated in support of the local government.
