AIR CRASH

On 12 June 06, Campbell River and Bella Coola SAR members responded to recover the occupants of a downed airplane near Bella Coola.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 16 June 06, Columbia Valley SAR assisted the RCMP with an evidence search in the Invermere area.

FLOOD

On 13 June 06, an intense rain storm occurred in Nelson dropping 5mm of rain in approximately 10 minutes. The flash flood, forced water over drains and down slope along the city streets. Several businesses and one residence sustained water damage. The City of Nelson activated the Incident Command System and first responders placed barricades in strategic locations for public safety and went door to door to downtown businesses to conduct a quick damage assessment. Power was shut off to many of the buildings as a safety precaution.

On 15 June 06, approximately 50 mm of precipitation fell in an 18 hour period driving Mission Creek above flood stage. Over bank flows were reported in the Joe Rich area south and east of Kelowna and flows along Mission Creek within the Kelowna City boundaries were at bank full conditions. 2 residential dwellings were impacted by flooding while another 8-10 residences were threatened. The City of Kelowna and the Central Okanagan Regional District activated a joint Emergency Operations Centre. The Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre in Kamloops and the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre were activated in support of the local authorities.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 16 June 06, Lions Bay Fire Rescue responded at the request of BCAS to assist with an injured logger who was 200 meters off the highway, 1 KM past Furry. The injured party was loaded onto the BCAS helicopter.
