WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT July 10-16 2006

LANDSLIDE

On 14 July 06, the City of Kimberley reported a slope failure had occurred as a result of heavy rains during the 5 to the 12 July. A section of the bank sloughed approximately 40 meters on the top, 80 on the bottom and 150 meters in length into the St. Mary's River, near St. Mary's Lake. There are approximately 20 water licenses downstream. The City shut down the sewer and barricaded the area. Crews continue to pump sewage from the lift station for transport to a collection system elsewhere until a solution is determined and remedial work conducted.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 10 July 06, City of Merritt activated their EOC to level 1 for the Merritt Mountain Music Festival.

On 14 July 06, 2 individuals from Prince George were provided ESS coverage after they were displaced from their residence due to a police matter.
